### The first Ride Muni to School week wrapped up with students across the City logging hundreds of transit trips!

**Highlights from the 2025 Ride Muni to School Week** 

Ride Muni to School week consisted of a ride contest and art contest. Students could participate in the ride contest by logging their transit or yellow school bus trips taken during March 1-9. While trips are still being counted, here are just some exciting

- Students logged 913 transit trips, totaling over 1,700 miles
- The current leading school recorded 294 trips, totaling over

19 schools (and counting!)

500 miles The current leading student logged 167 trips across five agencies, traveling almost 300

miles, over the nine-day contest

Student participants that logged rides and completed challenges will receive prizes, including a Ride Muni to School Week tote bag and an "I 🤎 Muni" notebook.
