## Celebrating another year of fun and safety

We are also pleased to announce the release of the [Safe Routes to School 2024-2025 annual report](#). It summarizes the programming Safe Routes hosted during the 2024-2025 school year, as well as results from the biennial travel tally. The highlights speak for themselves – Safe Routes continues to make it fun and easier for students and their families to choose one of the "Four Fun Ways" – walking, taking transit, biking and carpooling - to get to school, all while helping students gain the skills and confidence to travel independently.



Some stand-out statistics from our 2024-25 programming:

- Since the 2022-23 school year, single-family vehicle trips went down from 52% to 49% of all trips to school
- 19,000+ students and families participated across 209 Safe Routes events – a 78% increase in participants and 35% more events compared to 2023-24
- Three brand new activities: Our Walkable City, Street Safety Strolls, and Bike Repair Workshops
