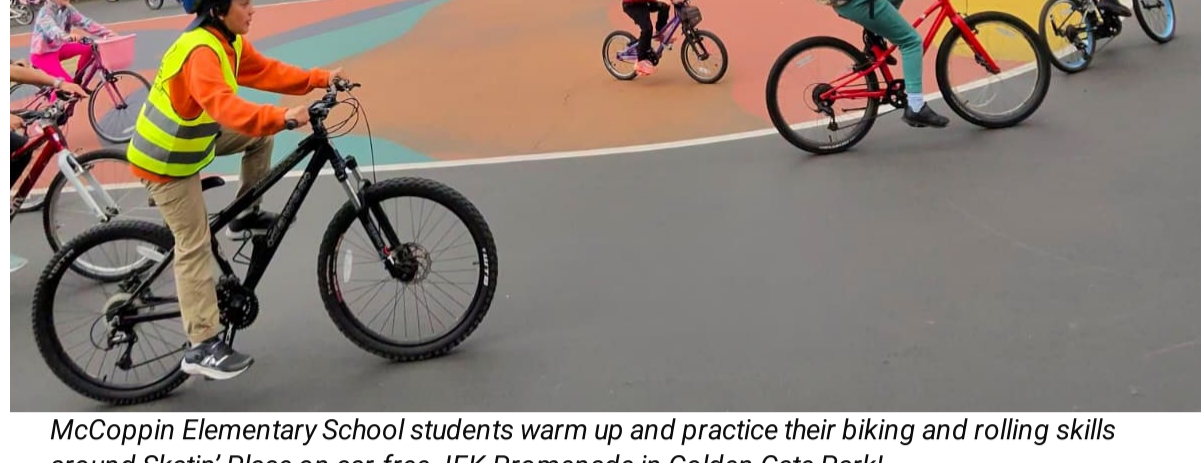
Bike & Roll to School Week Highlights

Did you know that Bike & Roll to School Week featured an art contest? This year's prompt was:

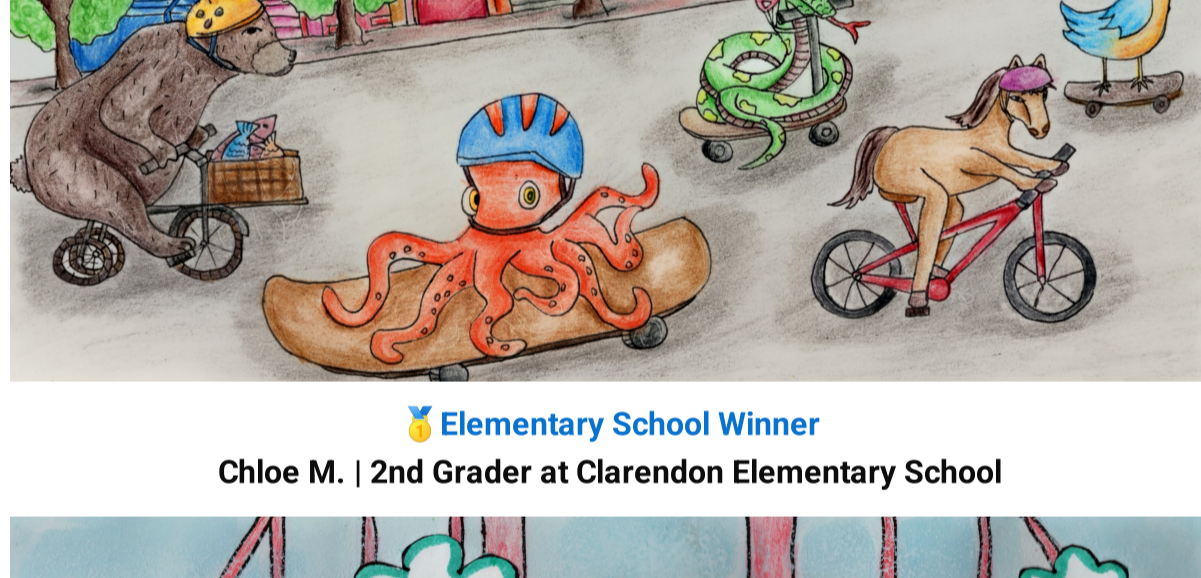
"Mascots on Wheels! Create an art piece showing your favorite mascot or animal biking or rolling in San Francisco."

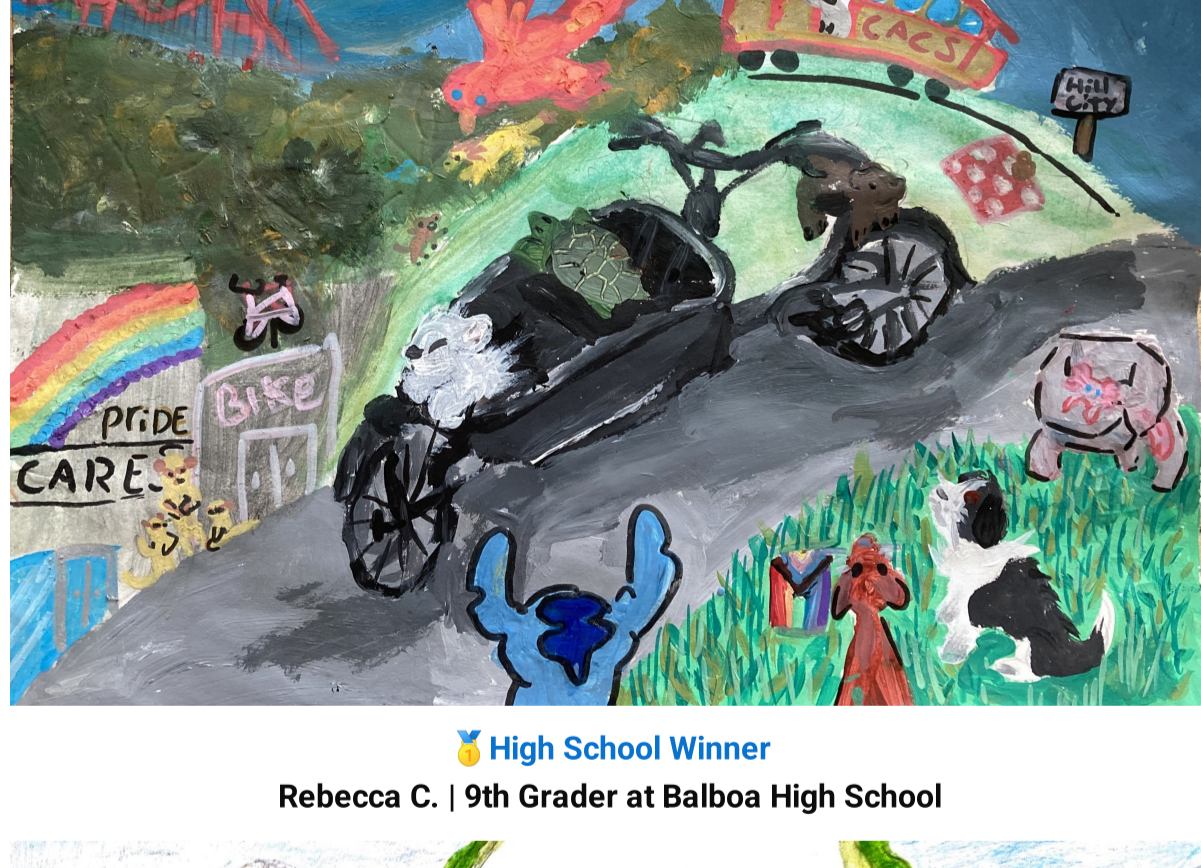

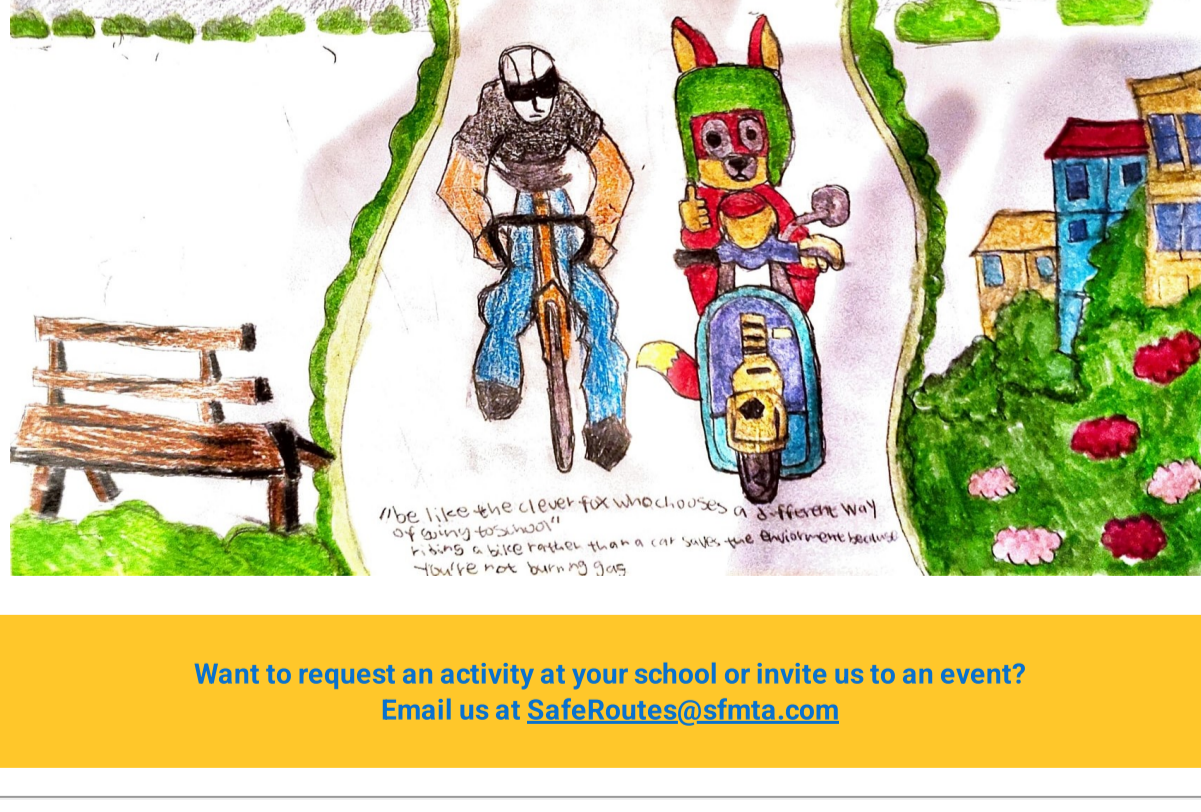

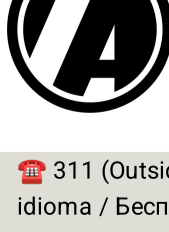
